### E-learning

Training assessments are a requirement under law (DSE reg.1992) – e-learning represents a cost effective way of providing efficient training across the board whilst screening more vulnerable employees. Our safety e-learning package delivers all the DSE essentials via a high-quality video presentation, including a full assessment to consolidate key learning points. Post-assessment, a full report and advisory support service are available to help users deal with any issues.

### Intervention Management

Effective auditing is an essential requirement of all health and safety legislation. Business Safety supply full DSE support via detailed documentation of all injuries, referrals and intervention. Our system includes the facility to refer complex cases to either external agencies or the relevant internal department as required – ensuring individual cases never slip through the net. We can also track all safety equipment levels and alert the administrator when stocks are running low.

### Onsite Assessment

On occasion organisational requirements dictate full on-site support from a team of highly-qualified, experienced consultants. Our service includes individual reports and recommendations. We currently offer two types of on-site assessment:  
 Basic – where no injuries are involved. Preventative measures are identified and future recommendations/actions produced.  
 Complex – usually where some injury has occurred, requiring specialist treatment or training. All assessments of this nature are undertaken by a registered osteopath or physiotherapist.

In those cases where assessments can be managed in-house, our [Target 100](#) software also enables managers to monitor workplace injuries comprehensively and expediently, ensuring duty of care is fulfilled from the point of incident right through to post-care and absence. Defining appropriate intervals, Injury Manager creates an audit trail of any referrals, notes or changes in status on a case by case status.

### Assessor training courses

Our basic assessor training package is designed to equip candidates with the knowledge and practical skills required to manage DSE assessments – both manually and as an e-learning follow-up session. Candidates are also taught how to manage any post-training requirements as they arise. We also offer an advanced training package, designed for experienced assessors and medical professionals, covers all aspects of the injury management and intervention process.
